SUMMER LEVEL 1

- May not have a functional communication system (speech, picture exchange or sign) OR may have 5 words or less in a functional communication system.
- May not tolerate groups
- May risk injuring themselves or others due to behaviours

SUMMER LEVEL 2

- Consistently uses 5 words or more in context
- Speaks with 1 or 2 word sentences
- Follows instructions such as “Come here” or “Stop”
- Not speaking in sentences or asking questions. “My favourite colour is blue. What about you?”

SUMMER LEVEL 3

- Will tolerate social environments and engagement
- Can participate in a group activity for at least 15 minutes
- Speaking in sentences or asking questions. “My favourite colour is blue. What about you?”

SUMMER LEVEL 4

- Advanced technology skills:
- Computer skills – cursor and keyboard (Coding & Robotics)
 - Using phone and computer for navigation (TTC Club)
